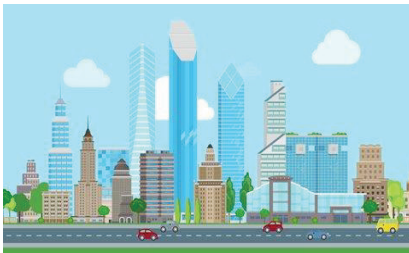

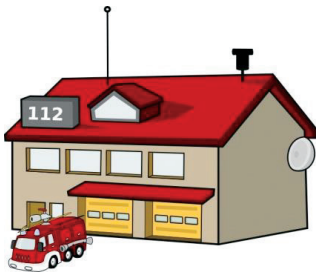

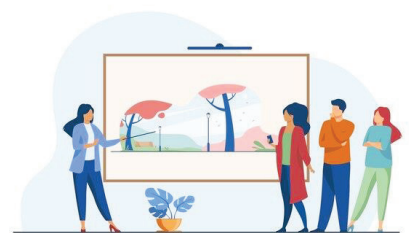

SATNAV technology makes my job a lot easier.

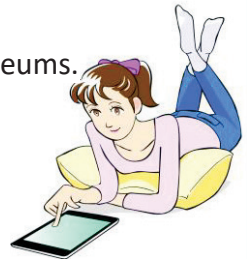


TABLETS – LUCY, 13

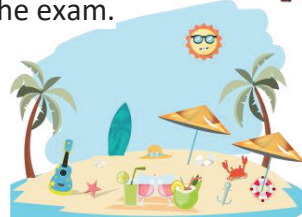

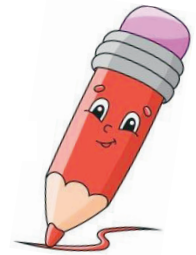

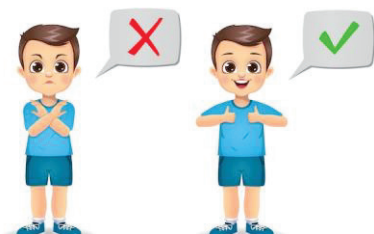
